### 1. **Welcome**

Mrs. Wallin welcomed parents and informed them of the upcoming survey that will be sent out to parents in the next month.

### 2. **LCAP 22/23 Year Review**

Mr. Morris presented Title I program and Engaging Parents/Families and Opportunities for Involvement.

Student asked what the maximum Lexile level for each grade level

Parents asked what LCAP was, what did it stand for.

Mrs. Wallin informed parents the LCAP is a tool for local educational agencies to set goals, plan actions, and leverage resources to meet those goals to improve student outcomes.

We've had 45% growth within the last year for our ELL population.

### 3. **Student expectations**

- a. Students **MUST** complete 6 credits per LP.  
1+2+1+2=6 credits
- b. Students **MUST** attend their scheduled appointments.
- c. 2x per week for 60 minutes minimum
- d. Students **MUST** follow all site policies and procedures when on campus.
- e. Students **MUST** dedicate 6-8 hours at home to school work per week.
- f. Students **MUST** check their school emails daily (it is encouraged for parents to check emails for important communications at least weekly).

Parent asked what is SGI

SGI is Small Group Instruction, students come in 2 times a week to meet their teacher in a classroom setting

## 4. Student Safety

We have been operating our new Safety Procedure since LP4.

Initially we did find that prohibited items such as vapes, pocket knives, and pepper spray were being brought on campus and had to be confiscated.

Now, after 2 months, we have found that prohibited items are rarely brought and confiscated, resulting in a safer learning environment.

Mrs. Wallin asked the parents and students present the following questions.

1. What feedback can you provide around this new procedure?  
-Student- At first she was confused as to why we were having this policy, but now in seeing the results and knowing students feel safe she understands why it has been put in place
2. Is there anything you would like to see implemented here to provide additional safety for our students?  
-Nothing at this time.
