4. Community Schools Grant Update

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AVLA received a **Community Schools Implementation Grant (2024–2029)** to expand academic and family supports.

Highlights include:

- Hiring a new **School Social Worker** focused on engagement and partnerships
- Upcoming offerings: parent workshops, on-site resources, community resource fair
- A new **steering committee** is forming—parents are invited to join and help shape future initiatives

5. Programs, Services & Supports

The following student supports were shared:

- Small Group Instruction (SGI): On-campus classes for core subjects
- **CTE Program:** Graphic Design pathway with Adobe certification
- **Dual Enrollment:** Free college courses earning high school and college credit
- Clubs: Black Student Alliance and Student Advisory Committee
- **Counseling Services:** Academic planning, college & career readiness, social-emotional support, and community resource referrals
