## **Meeting Minutes:**

#### Call to Order

#### Welcome and Introductions: 4:09-4:12

Principal Danyale Wallin welcomed all participants. Introductions included:

Roles and areas of support were explained to ensure families know who to contact for specific needs.

## Event Highlights: 4:12-4:17

Review of recent school events:

- Back-to-School Night, Spirit Week, and strong attendance/participation.
- NWEA Café incentive event where students enjoyed coffee and desserts.
- Counseling events: FAFSA Night, CSU application support.
- Parent workshops on disaster drills, vaping, narcotics, social media safety, and human trafficking.
- Upcoming schoolwide event: Community Resource Fair scheduled for April.

#### Cell Phone Escalation Protocol: 4:17-4:20

- Standard reminder that the site continues to follow the established escalation process for students who are in violation of the no cell phone policy.
- Staff and families were encouraged to reinforce appropriate use during instructional time.

## NWEA Data: 4:20-4:27

- The school achieved 97% participation in NWEA testing.
- Student performance data:
  - o 53% growth in both math and reading.
- Incentives and celebrations used to motivate participation and growth.

**CAASPP Data: 4:27-4:33** 



- School performance compared against other California charter schools was reviewed.
   Math proficiency is currently at 7%, identified as the primary area needing improvement.
- The site is implementing interventions and scaffolding strategies to boost math outcomes.
- Rolling enrollment remains a challenge that affects CAASPP performance metrics.

## CCSP: 4:33-4:49

Sarai (Community Programs Manager) reviewed the purpose and progress of the Community Schools grant.

- Four pillars highlighted:
  - 1. Integrated Student Supports
  - 2. Expanded Learning Opportunities
  - 3. Family & Community Engagement
  - 4. Collaborative Leadership
- Needs assessment results shared:
  - Need for stronger post-secondary planning support.
  - Additional assistance required for English Learners and socio-economically disadvantaged students.
  - Increased family engagement opportunities planned.
- The Community Resource Fair in April aligns with CCSPP goals.

## State and Federal Programs: 4:49-4:57

- Alex Morris reviewed key program compliance updates
- The school received a \$145,000 LREBG support grant, which will fund:
  - Math intervention teacher
  - Student incentives
  - The attendees appreciated the grant and like what AVLA is spending the money on.
- Additional academic resources (IXL platform for math)
