State and Federal Programs Update : 4:25-4:31

- **LCAP Goals:**

AVLA continues to focus on four key areas: student achievement, engagement, school climate, and college/career readiness.

Targeted Support Efforts:

- Differentiated Assistance (DA): Focused on improving math performance for targeted student groups
- Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI): Focused on increasing graduation rates through tutoring
- Tutoring impact: students earn 1 additional credit per learning period

Learning Recovery Funding (LREBG):

One-time funding now embedded in the LCAP, used for academic support, expanded learning, and student services to address learning loss.
